

Goodness & Light

This beanie was designed for Al, who is the gorgeous builder who put in our giant sliding door in the dining room, letting in so much “goodness and light”. The pattern is a slip stitch fairisle and is knit with double stranded dk throughout, making a cushy, warm and cozy beanie for working outside on the coldest days.

Measurements	To fit head circumference approx. 56cm
Yarn	Bendigo Woollen Mills Mystique DK approx 50g is colour A and 50g in colour B
Needles	6.00mm & 7.00mm circular needles
Gauge	16.5sts / 10cm stocking stitch
Other Notions	Large eye blunt needle

Cast on 72 sts in colour A using 6.00mm needles and join for working in the round.

Work in K2 P2 rib for approximately 10cm.

Change to 7.00mm needles.

Using A, knit 2 rounds, Using B, knit 1 round.

Round 1: Using A *k4 sl1 K2 sl1 rep from *

Round 2: Using B K1 *sl2 K2 rep from * to last 3sts sl2 K1

Round 3: Using A *K4 sl1 K2 sl1 rep from *

Round 4: Using B *sl1 K2 sl1 K4 rep from *

Round 5: Using A K1 *sl2 K2 rep from * to last 3sts sl2 K1

Round 6: Using B *sl1 K2 sl1 K4 rep from *

The last 6 rounds form pattern. Continue in pattern until work measure 26cm from beginning, ending with a sixth round.

Begin Decrease:

Round 1: Using A *K4 sl1 K2tog sl1 rep from *

Round 2: Using B K1 *sl2 K2 sl1 K2 rep from *

Round 3: Using A *K1 K2tog K1 sl1 K1 sl1 rep from *

Round 4: Using B *sl1 K1 sl1 K3 rep from *

Round 5: Using A K1 *sl1 K2 tog rep from *

Round 6: Using B *sl1 K1 rep from *

Round 7: Using A *K2tog K1 rep from * to last st K1

Round 8: Using B Knit

Round 9: Using A *K1 K2tog rep from *

Round 10: Using B Knit

Round 11: Using A K1 *K2tog rep from *

Cut yarn, leaving 10cm tail, thread yarn through remaining stitches and draw up tightly. Weave in ends.
